Their application to join a fellowship of Baptist churches was declined due to a lack of clear leadership structure. Nevertheless, the church remains committed to holding Sunday services and weekly gatherings, trusting the Lord to meet their leadership needs. We also had a wonderful time visiting the church in Saint-Denis and enjoyed deepening relationships during a church-wide BBQ following the service.
