- \* The funds needed for the move, setting up household in the DR and the purchase of ministry vehicles for us.
- \* Last minute doctors appointments.



"These things listed I commit to your care and provision. Give us the strength to endure these days. This is Your will for our lives, even at this point in our lives. Thank you for entrusting this task in planting churches in San Pedro with the help and teamwork of the members of the church in San Pedro. You have "many people in this city". Acts 18:10. You are with us. We are not afraid."
