Our surgical training program in partnership with the Pan-African Academy of Christian Surgeons (PAACS) is going well. We attended a conference in March with all the first-year residents throughout Africa.

Held outside Nairobi, Kenya, it was a wonderful experience to travel and also meet fellow missionary surgeons from all over the continent. The fellowship and Bible study were refreshing, and we came back encouraged and equipped to continue our investment in these residents' lives.

This program of Christian discipleship and professional surgical training allows us to fulfill our mission to train Christian leaders and raise up the next generation of believers. I had a special experience recently on call as I watched an abdominal surgery performed solely by our residents!



Specifically, we focused on how to improve our personal witness to others and the importance of a life worthy of the Gospel (Eph. 4:1) that backs up our words. This constant focus on the ultimate goal of HBB, to evangelize the lost and disciple the saved, will help us always be *more than a hospital*.
