But it also opened up opportunities to share the Gospel with adults that were interested in what was going on with the kids. We had many of these children and some visitors attend church in the weeks afterward. Please pray for those who heard the Gospel that they might come to faith in Jesus alone.



We have been asked to assist in planning and running the Winter Camps in July. A number of our young people will attend. Please pray for wisdom and grace for all serving at the camp that God will use it for the salvation of many and for God's work in those who are already saved.

Our Bible School students continue to be faithful in studying and doing their assignments. Please pray for those who are being trained for ministry and that God will raise up more pastors and missionaries.



It is encouraging to see the work that God is doing in the lives of those being discipled. At times we also face discouragement as we see some that are not willing to learn or listen to God. Please pray for God's intervention in the lives of those struggling and for His continued work in those obeying Him. Please also rejoice with us as we have seen some exciting growth in some as well!

Praise God with us that our co-worker, Terry Miller, finished her treatments for cancer and that she is in total remission! Please pray that she might remain cancer free and that she'll continue to regain her strength!

Zane finished kindergarten last week and is reading more and more. We are grateful for God's work in his life and his desire to ask people if they know Jesus and to give tracts wherever we go.
