We are reaching out to them and sharing the Gospel with them but with very little effect thus far. We need God's wisdom in how to reach these kids.

The monthly Ladies Bible Study is a wonderful time of fellowship and studying of God's Word. Amy has also been working with one of the ladies in getting her ready to hopefully teach one of these studies in the next month or two.

Our morning services are currently being preached in English and translated into Xhosa and Afrikaans. We realized that many struggle to fully understand English and this change seems to be well received and appreciated. Please pray for God's grace and wisdom how best to deal with the language challenges. We are also praying about the best way to start door to door visitation in order to reach more people with the Gospel. This can be challenging in the midst of increased gang violence once again.



We praise God that a few more churches recently informed us that they have taken us on for support increasing our promised support level to 84%. This is truly a miracle and we are grateful for His provision and continue to pray for the remainder of our support to come in, in His time.
