We love seeing them trust God for His grace to help them.



Bible School classes continue to be taught on Sunday evenings to those who are being trained for ministry. Our prayer and desire is that some of these students will surrender to becoming the next pastors, missionaries, and other ministry leaders in the churches that are being planted. This year we will be assisting in running the Winter Camps (opposite seasons here).
