We hope this prayer letter finds you doing well. God has been good to us, and a great part of His blessings have been through your prayers. I am thankful that we serve a God Who is able to do "...exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think..."

Thank you for praying for Jennifer's health. She continues to do well, praise the Lord. We have a follow up visit with her oncologist at the end of April and we have scheduled a short trip to Oklahoma. Your continued prayers are greatly appreciated.

Thank you for praying for our outreach during the Holiday Season. Our Christmas meal was a wonderful way to get the Gospel message to many people. We had 40 people attend with nine different countries represented. One of our visitors was a Muslim family from Turkey! They gladly accepted the small gifts that we gave along with several Gospel tracts. We are thankful for the doors that the Lord has opened recently in our efforts to evangelize.

Thank you for praying for our ministry as we start this new year of 2025. (En avant en 2025) We want to go forward in family units, as a church and in the Christian life. We have started a couple's class on Sunday afternoons. This is something new to many, but is necessary for the few young couples who come. In a few months, Lord willing, we will start classes on basic doctrines and what it means to be a member of the church. Later in the year we will have additional classes on Christian growth. Thank you for joining us in prayer that God will work in these three areas of our ministry

Toward the end of August, when the temperature rises, we will schedule a baptismal service. Most people prefer to be baptized in a lake or river, which is not very convenient in sub zero weather. One pastor described the Far North as being the land where "few are called and many are frozen." Praise the Lord, we already have a couple of people who are interested in following the Lord in Scriptural baptism. This is a big step for those who were once in the Catholic religion.

We are very thankful to have received a gift from one of our supporting churches for two signs for our building and also a piano keyboard. We are excited to have contacted a company to start on our new signs. People driving by will actually see that we are a church and not an exercise gym! We are also looking at the possibility of some minor renovations on the inside to make the building more usable. It is a special blessing to see some of our folks give what they can for specific projects.

Thank you for investing in souls around the world. You are making a difference in the lives of people in our little town of St-Quentin, New Brunswick.
