Dear friends and family,



However, we have seen the Lord's hand in it, and we are thankful.



We have officially finished the semester, and now we've entered a busy Christmas season! We hope that each one of you has a wonderful Christmas celebrating the birth of our Redeemer! Merry Christmas to all! For us, these days are filled with many goodbyes, Joanna's Portuguese evaluation (Dec. 18-19), celebrating on Christmas day, and packing before our arrival to the States at the beginning of January.

That leads us to our next steps. As mentioned, we head to the states in January! We are so excited to see those of you we can, and we plan to spend the bulk of our time in West Virginia, with time in Florida being bookends of this "home assignment." We will also be making a trip to Wisconsin and Missouri at the end of March, but it will be a quick one. At this point, we are hoping to be in the states until early May, at which point we will move to Manaus, Brazil in preparation for our move to our permanent ministry location with the X people group.

The reason that we even did this step of learning was so that we could develop relationships with our Brazilian brothers and sisters in Christ and learn as much as possible from them. Now, we are so grateful as we prepare to join an existing team with Brazilians. However, we are also saddened, because this means that we have to say hard goodbyes to those whom we've come to know and love in this corner of Brazil. One such couple is Diego and Thais. These friends from church have been such a blessing to us every Sunday we interact at church and beyond. Not only has Thais helped teach our girls about Jesus in Sunday school, but they as a couple have taught us things about their language and culture, and Diego taught us both how to drive a boat. It is these "See you later's" that will be one of the hardest parts of the next few months. We would appreciate your prayers for us in this as well as for our brothers and sisters here that also grieve the loss of yet another family coming through for a short time.
