
We have had lots of ministry going on over the past several months that has kept us on our toes! In September we had Dr. Jack and Mrs. Jenifer Mitchell as well as Dr. And Mrs. Hurlburt come out to Chuuk for a dental and medical trip. Though weather in Guam shortened the trip, we were able to minister to well over 100 people on two different islands and three different villages within the course of about a week! We had a blast and many people heard the Gospel before, during, or after receiving the medical attention they came for. Pray for continued results.

Shortly after the medical team left, Pastor Tom Phillips (who founded Grace International Baptist Church) came out with another small work team. We were able to accomplish many tasks at the church that we had fallen behind on as well as do a little work at the gym. It was a great trip and their labor and fellowship was a blessing to us.

Speaking of the gym, we were finally able to put a new roof on! We thank the Lord for this - no more leaks! I have ordered the equipment package and while we await its arrival the remaining renovations of painting, sealing the floor, and final touch-ups are being completed. Lord willing we will be ready to open within the next few months! We also praise the Lord that we were able to receive a five year grant through a program through the Chuuk hospital; this will be a tremendous help!

Sarah has also had opportunity to start a ladies Bible study once a month in which they are studying the book of Colossians. What an encouragement it was to have ten ladies attend the first meeting in November. As they continue to meet, pray that the ladies of our church and community begin to grow even more in their relationship with the Lord.
