Looking ahead to March, we have several significant ministry opportunities:





Thank you for your prayers, encouragement, and support. Utah is estimated at less than 2.5% Christian. We need your help to keep moving forward. We long to see a healthy church in every Utah town, and the Lord is doing a great work—through your partnership and prayers!

- **New Missionaries Arriving** – Three new female missionaries will be moving to Utah to serve in different church plants. We are excited to welcome them!

- **Church Planters' Conference** – We are hosting a summer camp for church planters, expecting 100-150 attendees, including children. Please pray that this event will be an encouragement to the entire church planting family—that the fellowship would be sweet, the sessions uplifting, and that even the children would be blessed by the time together.

In addition to these upcoming events, I recently wrapped up two teaching opportunities:

- **Marriage Conference** – We had 24 couples attend, ranging from newlyweds to those married for decades. It was a refreshing and encouraging time.
- **Christianity 101 Class** – Over five weeks, I walked 30 people through the foundations of the Christian faith, helping them see why Christianity is reasonable and life-giving.

Starting February 19, I will begin a **Living the Christian Life** class, guiding 25 students through five weeks of practical biblical teaching.
