Dear family and supporters.

Thank you for your prayers and support of our ministry. The last few months have been extremely busy. Since Diane stepped down from being the Director at the pregnancy resource center in October her plan was to spend two weeks a month helping take care of her mom. It was a good thought, but starting in November she ended up spending 8 out of 10 weeks in Michigan. I made three trips back and forth between the meetings that were on my schedule. The result of all of that is that it was decided that her mom needed to go into an assisted living facility. For those of you that have made that decision for your loved ones you know that it isn't easy. It also meant getting her house ready to go on the market to pay for her care. She just celebrated her 95th birthday at the facility. There are still times of adjustment ahead, so we keep praying.

For me, at the office we are in the process of changing our accounting and payroll programs. This means extra hours dealing with the many issues that continue to come up, getting all our information transferred and running correctly. I am traveling a little less with the new director in place but still visit a few colleges and universities. In March I will be at Cornerstone in Grand Rapids while Diane is visiting her mother. Then Sunday preaching at a supporting church. In May I go to Louisiana for a training class and commissioning for a missionary couple going to the Dominican Republic.

In June we will be involved in VBS programs at our home church and the new Ebenezer work. At the end of June Diane heads to Tulsa, Oklahoma to help a medical resident move from there to Florida for a fellowship. This is someone that she has been discipling since she was saved while studying here in Huntington. In July we will be leading a group from our church to Ireland to have a VBS for one of our missionaries there. Then finish up the summer going to Ecuador for another VBS. With everything else going Diane still wants to go to Michigan once a month to visit her mom. So, pray for traveling safety.

Be in prayer for Ebenezer Community Church. This is the new church plant I mentioned in our last prayer letter. A couple of weeks ago the young people from our church passed out some cards about the church starting up and there have been some responses and interest in coming. The team of workers is still coming together but we are excited about what God is doing. The first service will be on April 7 at 11am.
