### New Building

We continue to move forward on our plans to build a church building. Our hope is that our new location will allow us to create a dorm for seminary students who want to do an apprenticeship in church planting. As of a few months ago, Our Utah field became able to offer a Master of Divinity with an emphasis in church planting. The degree is fully accredited and costs less than \$10,000. They will not be the primary planters, but they will be key leaders on church plant teams. We are so thankful when God's people feel burdened to join the work taking place in Utah. We are seeing more people come to Christ than ever before.


### Death with Unbelievers

At the end of April, we mourned the passing of a leader in our church plant. Her name was Nancy, and she was a faithful saint that reached many lost souls and disciplined believers in the Lord. Nancy came from a Mormon background and her funeral was attended by a majority of unsaved people. I had the privilege of sharing the gospel during her funeral. The unbelievers in attendance kept commenting on how amazed they were by the love our church displayed to them. In fact, during the middle of the funeral, Nancy's mother-in-law (who is not a Christian) stood up to publicly acknowledge how overwhelmed she was by the depth of love our church extended to her family. It reminded me of Acts 2. As the church lived a devoted life toward Christ and each other, verse 47 says, "the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved." When the church displays a healthy gospel centric life, it becomes a powerful evangelistic tool.

### Several Outreach Events



This past month, our church conducted a community closet and a car show as a way to reach our community. Every six months our church collects clothing from our members and from a local thrifting store in order to host a community closet. All of the clothing we receive is placed on several tables and tarps and offered to the community for free. We allow anyone that has a need to show up and fill a bag



with clothing. This event has led to people getting saved, baptized, and joining our church. In addition, we also hosted our 2<sup>nd</sup> annual car show. This year we had over 50 cars showcased, and hundreds of people participated. The gospel was shared, and we also offered food for a donation. The money we raised was used to provide a vehicle for a missionary without transportation.

### Christian Radio Station

I continue to be a guest on a local Christian Radio Station called Key Radio. This Radio Station is owned by our church planting organization and run by missionaries Mike and Heather Zander. The station reaches several counties in Utah. We are currently looking for another missionary to help serve at the radio station.
