**MONDAYS:** I have training that I complete each week that is facilitated by my coworker, the legend - Tom Bridges.

**TUESDAYS:** Our Carrollton Team has Tuesday Lunches where we have a table with flyers & goodies we hand out to students. Our Cru students often sit & chat with us. We also encounter many other students who pause to chat & then head on to lunch. This is a great way we get to interact with many students!

- Also Apprentice\* Adelyn & I started a Girl's Bible Study that has since morphed into a Tuesday Girl's Hangout where we provide a space for the girls to bring friends & have open, spiritual conversations.

**WEDNESDAYS:** Our Carrollton Team started Cru Wednesday meetings back up this January. We're looking forward to seeing more students come for fun & fellowship on-campus afterschool.

**THURSDAYS:** Dallas (Carrollton & Plano) Team meets to share, pray & plan.

**FRIDAYS:** Apprentice Nathan is currently raising support as he thinks about joining part-time staff. We meet for support-raising training & encouragement.

- Carrollton Team has a planning meeting where we pray, discern & plan where to focus our attention each week.

- Apprentice Adelyn & I meet for one-on-one mentorship. We also assess the week's girl's meetings, pray & adapt where we feel the Lord leading us in best serving them.

**FLEXIBLY:** When I'm not immediately in a meeting, I am:

- attending student games or events
- inviting students to events
- meeting one-on-one with girls for discipleship
- creating curriculum to be taught at meetings
- planning for future events
- support raising
