## Jesus Loves Me | Made to Create

### What You Need

### What You Do:

*Before the Activity:* Copy "Jesus Loves Me" on cardstock, one per child. Copy "Jesus Loves Me Heart" on cardstock and cut, one cutout per child. Take each child's picture and print. Cut pictures if needed. Write each child's name on their paper.

*During the Activity:* Encourage children to decorate their heart cutout and put aside. Clean hands as needed. Ask children to glue their picture to the box on their paper. Help children position their decorated heart over their picture and place a piece of washi tape on the top part of the left side of each child's heart.

*After the Activity:* Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

### What You Say:

*Before the Activity:* "Friends, come join me at the table and let's create something special to help us remember who Jesus loves—that's you!"

*During the Activity:* "What shape is this? (*Hold up a heart.*) That's right! It's a heart, and hearts make us think of love! This heart has words on it, they say 'Who does Jesus love?' Decorate the side with words any way you want. (*Pause.*) Fantastic! Now let's add your picture to the box on this paper. (*Point.*) Rub a little glue in the box then stick your picture right there. (*Pause.*) Now take the beautiful heart you decorated and lay it on top of your picture. (*Help position and place a piece of tape at the top left curve of the heart. Make a bend right under the edge of the tape so the heart can lift then lay flat.*) Okay friends, the words on your heart say Who does Jesus love? Lift your heart and let's find out. (*Pause.*) It's you! Jesus loves you! That's right! Jesus loves [child's name], and [child's name], and [child's name], and ... (*continue saying each child's name!*)"

*After the Activity:* "Today in our true story from the Bible, Jesus shared a story about a shepherd and his one hundred sheep. The shepherd loved all his sheep and took good care of them but one day one of his sheep went missing! The shepherd left all his other sheep and went to look for the one lost sheep. When he found it, he was so happy! The shepherd put the sheep on his shoulders and carried it home to the other sheep then he celebrated with his friends and family! Friends, Jesus loves everyone just like the shepherd loved his sheep. Tell me, **who loves you? [Bottom Line] Jesus loves me!** That's right! Say it one more time. **Who loves you? [Bottom Line] Jesus loves me!**"
