BIG IDEA: God's work in our salvation gives us the motivation to live the mission He has for us.

# APPLICATION GUIDE

APRIL 27, 2025

## DISCUSS

When have you felt deeply moved or inspired to do something selfless for someone else? What motivated you in that moment?

Read Titus 1:1–3. What do Paul's three stated purposes for his apostleship reveal about God's priorities in salvation?

Read John 6:37–40. What do we learn about the relationship between the Father and Son?

Read 2 Corinthians 4:3–6. What does Paul say is the reason some do not understand the gospel, and how does this explain the need for the Spirit's role in regeneration?

What other passage that was shared in the message impacted you? Why?

In what ways does each person of the Trinity participate in our salvation, and how should that impact the way we live out our faith?

If the mission of God is grounded in His eternal promise and power, how does that change the pressure we feel in sharing the gospel?

## APPLY

How does understanding that you're part of God's eternal love gift to the Son change the way you view your purpose?

In what areas of life are you tempted to rely on your own strategy rather than the Spirit's power for transformation?

What would it look like in your context to trust that God is working behind the scenes as you share the gospel? How can you creatively engage others with the message of the gospel while trusting God for the outcome?
