Last Sunday, the Trinity voting membership considered a proposal for Diocesan Transfer, as follows:

Trinity Lafayette, gathered for a Special Meeting on November 26, 2023:

- Whereas our Rector, the Rev'd Dr. Peter Johnston, will be requesting transfer to the Diocese of All Nations;
- And whereas the Diocese of All Nations is a good fit for Trinity in our ministry and mission;

We hereby request diocesan transfer, from the Diocese of the Western Gulf Coast to the Diocese of All Nations.

The proposal was passed by a vote as follows:

18 – No

2 – Abstain
