

SPECIAL MEETING of TRINITY ANGLICAN CHURCH

November 26th 2023

A Special Meeting was called to vote on a decision whether Trinity Anglican Church would continue in the ACNA Diocese of the Western Gulf Coast or request transferring our diocesan affiliation to the ACNA Diocese of All Nations.

Bill Cober read the resolution to the members present.

Deacon Adam Hunter Read the Pastoral letter from Bishop Clark Lowenfield.

Pat Briney read the Letter of Agreement between Bishop Clark Lowenfield and the Rev. Dr. Peter Johnson.

Fr. Peter Johnson gave a statement on the Diocese of All Nations and opened the floor for question and answers. After much discussion was had a vote was called for.

The votes were collected and counted by Dave Buckless, Peoples Warden and John Guillory, Acting Secretary. After counting the votes the results were:

Votes to transfer to the Diocese of All Nations 39

Votes to remain in the Diocese of the Western Gulf Coast 18

Abstentions 2

Rector's Warden Bill Cober received the results and announced them to the parish.

Fr. Peter Johnson received the results and will inform Bishop Clark Lowenfield Trinity Anglicans decision for transfer. Fr. Peter will then submit a request for transfer to the Diocese of All Nations.
