1. Who did Jesus call as disciples in Mark 1:16-20, and 2:14-17? What details are given about these men? What do you think about when you see the way in which they followed Jesus? What makes it hard to do something immediately?
2. Who are the disciples of John mentioned in verse 18?
3. What do verses 19-20 teach us about fasting? When you think about fasting what does it mean to you? What thoughts does it trigger?
4. In Mark 1, In Mark 2, and in Mark 8:34-37 from our vision message, all have attributed their being a cost to being a disciple of Jesus. If you were to explain to a new believer the cost to being a disciple of Jesus what would you say?
5. What are testimonies of “cost” in your life?
6. Mark 3:7 It says Jesus “withdrew” with his disciples. What importance can we gain from this idea of withdrawing? How can you practice this in your own life?
7. Mark 3:14-15 Jesus appointed the disciples to do what? Is everyone that is saved a Disciple? What are some practical ways that everyone can “preach?”
