# 3s/4s Lesson Plan - Worship Service

*Sunday, January 25*

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### **THIS WEEK'S LESSON:** The Wisdom of God's People - Proverbs

King Solomon was very wise. He wrote or said short, wise sayings called proverbs. The book of Proverbs helps us know the right things and make good choices.

Some of the things Solomon said were:

- remember and respect God—only unwise people ignore God
- follow God's rules if you want to live a long, happy life
- be kind to others
- trust God with all your heart
- stay away from people and things that are wrong
- don't get mad when God corrects you—God corrects us because He loves us.

In Solomon's proverbs, he showed people how to live in ways that please God.

**Christ Connection:** Solomon wrote a book of wise sayings. Jesus always did what was wise and good. We can follow his example!

### **MEMORY VERSE of the Month:** PROVERBS 3:7 - "Fear the LORD, and turn away from evil." (ESV)

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### Volunteer Huddle | **9:40 a.m.**

Grab your nametag at the check-in desk and then meet in the room (Room #126) to the left of the desk for prayer and important info for this Sunday. If possible, please wear your Fellowship Church t-shirt or Fellowship hoodie.

### Enter and Prep Room | **9:50 a.m.**

- Prep room for any activities you will do during the lesson.
- **Fill up the pitcher** in the Teacher Box (yellow lid) with water so that it is ready for snack time.

## Activity Pages + Free Play | 9:45 - 10:15 am

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One volunteer should greet children and families at the door.

### TRANSITION TEAMS

Switch in for the Sunday School volunteer team and receive any information from them if needed. Take over the roster and welcome at the door any new children checking in for the worship service hour.

### ACTIVITY PAGES

Invite children to the tables and pass out the week's **Activity Page** (in Activity Box) and **crayons** (in Teacher Box) to each child. After they have finished their pages, they can play freely with toys or books.

**During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.**

### PREPARE SNACKS

While children are playing, prepare the snacks. Fill up the pitcher with water and distribute Cheerios in the cups. You don't need to place the snacks on the table yet, just have it ready to go in cups.

**GIVE EXPECTATION :** Give children a **warning** before you ask them to line up.

**SAY** "Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and get ready for worship!"

*Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a line.*

## Worship Time | 10:20 am

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Have children sit in a circle on the ground. On the **Spotify** app on the TV, pull up the **Preschool Worship Time playlist**.

- For the first three songs, sing and follow the motions of the song: *Good Morning God, My God is So Big, If You're Happy and You Know It.*
- For the next two songs - *Jesus is Alive, Jesus Loves Me* - pull out the instruments from the Preschool Worship Time box and allow children to grab them and play and dance along with the music.

- For the last song - *Jesus Loves Little Children* - you can turn off the classroom light, have children put away instruments, sit back down on their mats, and listen quietly to help them calm back down.

## Snack + Lesson Review | 10:40 am

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**Have students sit at the tables for snack time.**

1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (*YouTube account should be Fellowship Kids (switch accounts on the top of the left sidebar if not) > go to Library on the left side bar > Choose Playlists on the top > choose your classroom*).

## Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

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### MAKE A SCROLL

Write *Trust in God* on a piece of paper (one per child). Allow children to decorate their scrolls using markers, crayons, or stickers. Instruct kids to roll the short sides of their papers together and twist closed with a **pipe cleaner** (in Activity Box). Review the Bible story.

**SAY** King Solomon taught that people should trust in God. Jesus trusted in God and followed His plan to rescue sinners. Can we trust in God too? Yes! When we trust in Jesus, He helps us know the right things and make good choices.

### SOLOMON SAYS

Tell the children that you are going to play a game with them called, “Solomon Says,” which is similar to “Simon Says.” Instruct the children to listen carefully to what you are saying. If they hear the phrase “Solomon Says” before an instruction, they need to do the motion you tell them. However, if they do not hear you say, “Solomon Says” they need to do nothing. If a child does an action that is not preceded by “Solomon Says” gently and playfully point them out, but allow them to continue to play the game in the next round. Example actions: touch your nose, tap your foot, turn around.

**SAY** Did you have trouble remembering to only do the things Solomon said to do? King Solomon was wise. He wanted to help people know how to do the right things and make good choices. Solomon taught that people should trust God. We gain wisdom when we trust in God. Jesus trusted in God, His Father, and followed His plan to rescue sinners.

## Free Play: Special Toys | 11:10 am

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### WORSHIP SERVICE TOYS BOX

Pick up any toys that are currently out in the room and put them back into the Toy Box. Then, take out the **Worship Service Toys box** (toys and activities that only come out at the end of the service) and encourage children to play. Use this time to engage with children, ask them questions from the lesson, and get to know them better.
