Twos Lesson Plan - Worship Service

Sunday, January 18

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: The Queen of Sheba Visited Solomon - 1 Kings 10

The queen of Sheba heard that King Solomon was very wise, so she came to meet him and ask him very hard questions. She traveled far from her kingdom to Israel. She brought lots of gifts with her—camels with spices, gold, and shiny rocks.

She talked to Solomon about everything she was curious about, and he answered all her questions. She was so surprised by everything she saw: his wisdom, his big palace, the yummy food, and good servants.

The queen said, “Wow! The stories I heard were true! You’re even wiser and richer than I thought. Your people must be so happy. Praise God for making you king and giving you wisdom to be fair and do the right things.”

Then she gave Solomon lots of gold, spices, and shiny rocks. She also gave him wood to make cool instruments and stairs for the temple.

Solomon gave the queen everything she wanted, and then she went back home with her helpers.

Christ Connection: *Like the queen was surprised by King Solomon's wisdom, people were also surprised by Jesus' teaching. Jesus is God's Son and he has all wisdom. He taught with power because He is the King of everything. Jesus came to show us how to live and to save us by dying and coming back to life.*

Volunteer Huddle | 9:40 a.m.

TRANSITION TEAMS

Switch in for the Sunday School volunteer team and receive any information from them if needed. Take over the roster and welcome at the door any new children checking in for the worship service hour.

ACTIVITY PAGES

Invite children to the tables and pass out the week's **Activity Page** (in Activity Box) and **crayons** (in Teacher Box) to each child. After they have finished their pages, they can play freely with toys or books.

During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.

PREPARE SNACKS

While children are playing, prepare the snacks. Fill up the pitcher with water and distribute Cheerios in the cups. You don't need to place the snacks on the table yet, just have it ready to go in cups.

GIVE EXPECTATION : Give children a **warning** before you ask them to line up.

SAY "Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and get ready for worship!"

Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a line.

Worship Time | 10:20 am

Have children sit in a circle on the ground. On the **Spotify** app on the TV, pull up the **Preschool Worship Time playlist**.

- For the first three songs, sing and follow the motions of the song: *Good Morning God, My God is So Big, If You're Happy and You Know It.*
- For the next two songs - *Jesus is Alive, Jesus Loves Me* - pull out the instruments from the Preschool Worship Time box and allow children to grab them and play and dance along with the music.
- For the last song - *Jesus Loves Little Children* - you can turn off the classroom light, have children put away instruments, sit back down on their mats, and listen quietly to help them calm back down.

Snack + Lesson Review | 10:40 am

Have students sit at the tables for snack time.

1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (*YouTube account should be Fellowship Kids (switch accounts on the top of the left sidebar if not) > go to Library on the left side bar > Choose Playlists on the top > choose your classroom*).

Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

TOSS A BEANBAG AND ANSWER QUESTIONS

Gather children in a circle. Say that you are going to toss a beanbag to each child while asking a simple question. Instruct children to answer your question while tossing the beanbag back to you. Ask each child a very simple question: *What color is your hair? What color are your eyes? What is the weather like outside? How many brothers and sisters do you have? Who brought you to church today? What did you eat for breakfast? What color is a fire truck? What is your favorite color?*

SAY *The questions that I asked you were easy. But in today's Bible story, the queen of Sheba visited King Solomon and asked him riddles. Riddles are hard questions. Solomon answered all her riddles. Like the queen was surprised by King Solomon's wisdom, people were also surprised by Jesus' teaching. Jesus is God's Son and he has all wisdom. He taught with power because He is the King of everything.*

Free Play: Special Toys | 11:10 am

WORSHIP SERVICE TOYS BOX

Pick up any toys that are currently out in the room and put them back into the Toy Box. Then, take out the **Worship Service Toys box** (toys and activities that only come out at the end of the service) and encourage children to play. Use this time to engage with children, ask them questions from the lesson, and get to know them better.
