While we are still rejoicing over a successful RUF Global Africa Training and an exciting start of 2026 for RUF-UCT, we ask you to please pray for Pamela and her family. She has travelled back to the States to be with her parents and brother after her mother suffered a stroke.

A huge Thank You for the prayers and financial support that helped make the RUF Global Africa Training 2026 possible. We had 35 participants from across Africa. Seven nations were invited. Five amazing RUF trainers came from the US to teach and serve us. Please pray for the fruit of the Spirit to glow onto our campuses across Africa.

7,000 first year students have arrived at University of Cape Town. Our gazebo stall on campus introduced students to RUF-UCT and our Life Skills seminars. Praise God for divine appointments and connections with dozens of students. We'll update you again soon about our follow-up with students interested in our Bible studies and large group Friday Fellowship.

Please pray for young leaders: Sean, Tshepiso, Jami, Naomi and Elijah. We are so thankful for the young leaders developing at Sikhona Covenant Presbyterian Church and Life Skills-RUF. Sikhona has outgrown its initial location in the UCT School of Music. In March we will move to a nearby school, adjacent to campus.

On Saturday morning, February 7, Pamela received an urgent call from her brother. He had arrived at their parents' home and found their mother, Magdoline (turning 85 on March 10) had suffered a serious stroke. Pamela flew to Missouri and plans to stay until her mother is released from the hospital to a step-down care home. Mag has been the sole caregiver for their father Leland, who has dementia. So, there were, and still are, some very big decisions to be made and changes to come. Please pray for Mag's rehab and recovery, and for the Lord to provide a care home near family that would provide for their needs, both now and in the future.
