SERIES PROFILE: WHOLE FAITH-LIVING ORGANICALLY FOR JESUS

Tagline: Living organically for Jesus

Idea: Fast food may delight the tongue, but it slowly destroys the body. God is calling us to live an organic, whole foods kind of faith that will nourish us and make us strong.

Memory Verse: *"Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me."* -Psalm 51:10 (NIV)

Lessons:

Read The Label – If you want to eat nutritiously, you have to learn to read food labels. Students will learn that the spiritually whole read and know the word of God. Luke 4:1-13, The Temptation of Jesus

Buy Fresh – If you want to be healthy, you need to eat fresh, whole foods. Students will learn that those who make praise and celebration a priority keep their spiritual lives fresh. Luke 17:11-19 & 18:35-43, Jesus Heals Ten Lepers and A Blind Beggar

Balanced Diet – The healthiest diet is one that balances the right mix of carbs, proteins, and fats. Students will learn that for a balanced spiritual life, they need to bring prayer into the mix. Matthew 6:5-18, Prayer and Fasting

Organic – The healthiest diet is one filled with foods that are organically grown. Students will learn that a life filled with service to others grows out of an organic, authentic faith. John 13:1-17, Jesus Washes His Disciples' Feet
