## THE MANDATE

The Bible is the ultimate good news! From beginning to end, it's the story of God's unstoppable love for us. Even when humanity turned away, God didn't give up; He sent Jesus, His Son, to rescue and restore us. Jesus, fully God and fully human, walked among us, felt our struggles, and sacrificed Himself so we could be free from sin and in relationship with Him again. His death and resurrection changed everything! If you've experienced this incredible love, you know the power of saying "yes" to Jesus. But what happens next? Does God's story end with the Bible? Or are we, like the first disciples, called to keep it going? Ephesians 1:22-23 tells us Jesus is the head of the Church, not a building, but a movement of people. In Scripture, the word for Church is *ekklesia*, meaning "called-out ones." That means us, believers around the world, carrying out His mission every day. We call this "missions," but it's not just for those traveling overseas.

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

## WHAT'S MISSIONS

The root word *missio* means "to send," and missions is all about being sent out to build the Kingdom. Whether it's a missionary in a remote village, a local outreach to those in need, giving to support gospel work, or simply sharing Jesus with a friend—that is missions. It's every believer, everywhere, working together to grow and increase God's Kingdom.

As followers of Christ, we are all Kingdom Builders—called to take the good news of Jesus to the world. When we give financially, serve, and support missions, we're not just helping a cause, we're actively fulfilling Jesus' command in Mark 16:15 to "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." (NIV) Kingdom Builders isn't just a name; it's a lifestyle of generosity, obedience, and faith. As we step into this new season of missions, we invite you to be part of what God is doing. 
## VISION

## PROJECT RESCUE

Project Rescue is a global network of passionate partners working together to bring hope and healing to survivors of sexual exploitation and slavery. Based in the U.S., their team supports women and child survivors across central and southern Asia, Europe, and Africa. By teaming up with local organizations, they help create long-term, culturally-aware programs that provide holistic care and empower survivors to rebuild their lives.



## BUILDERS INTERNATIONAL

Builders International connects volunteers and donors with dynamic missionaries and trusted community leaders around the world to build physical places where people find hope! Builders International has direct access to an international supply chain and delivery system for reaching people with the gospel and serving people in their greatest time of need. Their projects have long-term sustainability and show a great return on investment as they enable proven community champions to do the work of the Kingdom.

## HOPE FLEET

HOPE Fleet is an international private boating organization empowering Caribbean church and community partners to better care for children and families. They deliver aid to communities with little access to vital resources by partnering with local pastors and missionaries for distribution. HOPE Fleet is also developing the first sea-based human trafficking reporting app, enabling boaters to combat trafficking on water. Through supplies, volunteering, and awareness, the boating community can create lasting, tangible impact, and HOPE Fleet helps make that impact possible.

## PHILADELPHIA DREAM CENTER

The Philadelphia Dream Center serves North Philadelphia and Kensington, reaching children and adults in "Needle Park," known for drug dealers and addiction. They reach victims of trafficking, substance abuse, and life-controlling issues, sharing the love of Jesus through outreach, a planted church, and a growing facility today.



## FIRE BIBLES PROJECT

Life Publishers International is a global ministry of Assemblies of God World Missions, publishing Fire Bibles and Christian literature to communicate the gospel of Jesus Christ. Around 1.45 billion people in the world don't have a Bible in their first language. This number represents about 20% of the global population. The goal of the Fire Bibles team is to print the Fire Bibles in the top 100 languages of the world, many of which represent completely unreached people groups.



## GIDEONS INTERNATIONAL

Gideons International is an association of Christian business and professional men and their wives dedicated to telling people about Jesus through service, sharing personal testimony, and providing Bibles and New Testaments. While they are often recognized for their work with hotels, they also place and distribute Scriptures in other strategic locations so they are available to those who want them, as well as to those who may find them in a time of need.

## ASIA'S LITTLE ONES

Since 1990, Asia's Little Ones has provided lifelines to orphaned, abandoned, and vulnerable children across the Asia Pacific. As a Christian nonprofit, ALO believes every child deserves a safe place to belong, access to medical care, and the opportunity to know Jesus so they can grow into who God created them to be. Each initiative takes a holistic approach, addressing children's physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual needs while sharing God's love and hope at the heart of every project.

## CONVOY OF HOPE

Convoy of Hope is a faith-based organization passionate about feeding the world and sharing the love of Jesus through children's initiatives, community outreach, and disaster response. Partnering with local churches, businesses, and civic organizations, Convoy of Hope provides strategic help and hope to communities worldwide!





## TEEN CHALLENGE

For over 60 years, Teen Challenge has helped individuals find freedom from addictions and life-controlling issues through Christ-centered programs. Their adult residential programs focus on lifelong recovery from addictions that destroy an individual's life and future. Those seeking freedom from substance abuse find a haven of hope at Teen Challenge, discovering recovery tools rooted in biblical principles that lead to healing, growth, and healthy relationships.



## THRIVE

Thrive is a faith-based nonprofit in Cape Coral, Florida, that empowers pregnant women and single mothers to reach their God-given potential. As the Thrive team meets the physical needs of each woman and her children, the mother can focus on becoming strong and wise. Each woman residing at the Thrive, SWFL safe home is given the opportunity to further her education, receive job training, and learn how to care for herself, her children, and her home.

## BETTER TOGETHER

Better Together is a Florida-based Christian organization making a real difference for families in crisis. Since 2015, they have helped over 10,000 children and 38,000 job seekers through two programs, Better Families and Better Jobs. Their mission is to empower people who want to help themselves by preventing child abuse, keeping families out of the foster care system, and connecting job seekers with employers willing to offer a second chance. When disasters strike, Better Together responds quickly, providing relief for at-risk families through community connections.

## PREGNANCY RESOURCE CENTERS OF SWFL

Pregnancy Resource Center provides medical services such as ultrasounds, pregnancy tests, abortion pill reversal, pre- and post-natal education, and ongoing support to women and families facing unplanned pregnancies. When a woman chooses life for her baby, PRC walks alongside her and the whole family with counseling, parenting classes, and many other resources to make sure she is supported in her decision until after the birth of the child.



## CITY TAKERS SWFL

City Takers SWFL exists to reach and transform hip-hop culture with the gospel by loving, drawing in, and building people. Through this cycle, they multiply urban missionaries who lead change in their city. City Takers SWFL is a movement of radical love serving the poor and marginalized so all can experience Jesus through mentorship, concerts, outreaches, evangelism, and practical support.



## LIFEWISE ACADEMY SWFL

LifeWise Academy is a mission organization working to bring released-time Bible studies to public school students across SWFL and the nation. These programs allow students to explore their faith during school hours, all within a legal framework that's as solid as it is respectful of our nation's values. LifeWise Academy recruits local Christian volunteers to serve the students and share with them Biblical truths and the Gospel. Here in SWFL, LifeWise is operating in multiple public schools already, and hopes to expand to many more.

## RIDE NATURE

Ride Nature is a mission organization based out of Fort Myers that is dedicated to giving generously, proclaiming the Gospel, and making disciples through action sports outreach, evangelism and discipleship. Their mission work is both local to SWFL and also reaches internationally through their global mission bases and various mission trips and outreaches.

## IMAGINE INITIATIVE

The Imagine Initiative exists to bring help, hope, and healing, sparking transformation in schools and the communities around them. They envision a day when every school is partnered with a local church in a deep, relational way that leads to lasting change. We currently partner with the Imagine Initiative to impact Orangewood Elementary, a public school less than 1 mile from our church.

## RETIREMENT FACILITIES OUTREACH

The Retirement Facilities Outreach of our church serves over 20 care facilities in Lee County each month. This mission brings comfort and compassion to those facing end-of-life or long-term care. Dozens of volunteers share the gospel, lead chapel services, and offer prayer and friendship.



# FUTURE

## YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT MISSION TRIP SCHOLARSHIPS

We love providing opportunities for youth and young adults to go on mission trips where they can encounter Kingdom work in a new context. While these young people do work to raise their own funds for trips, in the future, we hope to be able to provide scholarships for First Assembly youth and young adults who feel called to participate in global mission trip opportunities.



## FORT MYERS CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

Fort Myers Christian School was established in 1979 by First Assembly of God. Serving grades VPK-8th in a Christian-based academic setting, it is their goal that each student be academically and spiritually successful. They believe this can only be fully attained through a combined effort of the home, school, and church. FMCS is fully accredited through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).



## CONTINENTAL THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY (BELGIUM)

Continental Theological Seminary, a pentecostal center for higher education, exists to provide theological studies in an international environment to prepare men and women for Christian ministry and challenge them to develop spiritually, intellectually, emotionally, and culturally in order to serve God and their fellow man.



## ASIA PACIFIC THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

APTS exists to prepare ministerial leaders for the Pentecostal/Charismatic churches of the Asia Pacific region, and to serve as a resource center for assisting these churches to fulfill their biblical mandate. To this end, APTS provides advanced leadership training within the Pentecostal/Charismatic tradition and a variety of theological, educational, and ministry services that seek to develop and enhance the effectiveness of the churches and students it serves.

## PACIFIC OCEANIA BIBLE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS (PACIFIC OCEAN)

Our church has for several years provided scholarships for pastors and missionaries from the remote islands of the Pacific to attend Bible college, gaining the training, practical guidance, and spiritual formation they need. Many return to plant churches in unreached regions, equip local leaders, and serve communities with lasting impact.
