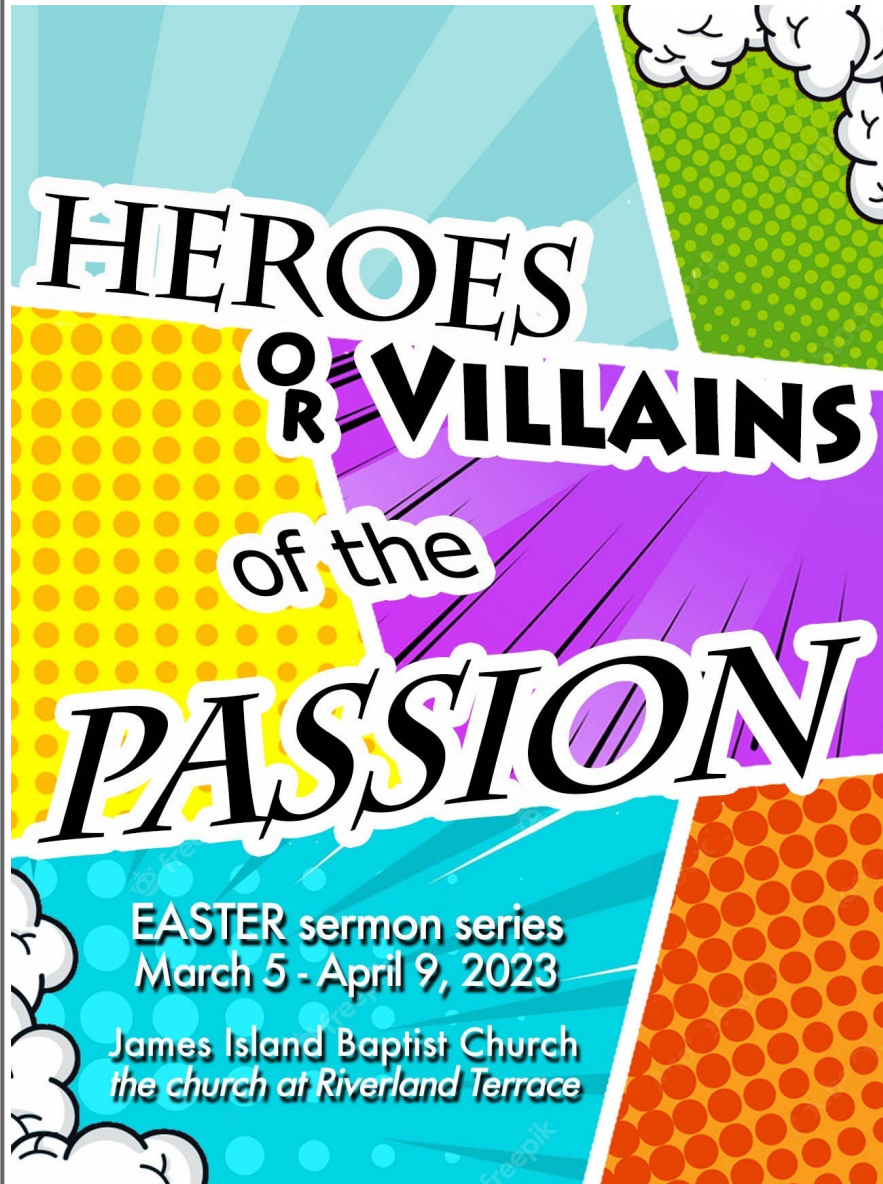

We will also be collecting a special offering to go to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering. We once were asked “Who is this Annie Armstrong and will we ever get her paid off?” One day, when Christ returns, we will not have any more mission offerings. Until then, let’s continue to give generously.

Annie Armstrong was born in 1850 and died in 1938. She provided visionary leadership as she organized women to pray, to give and to meet the needs of those around them. She constantly challenged pastors and churches to action and rallied vital support for missionaries. In 1934, just 4 years before she died, The Southern Baptist Home Mission Board renamed their Home Mission Offering. The new name was The Annie Armstrong Easter Offering. She was an inspiration to thousands and she continues to be. Try googling her name and read the inspirational stories and the great accomplishments that came from serving the Lord. You will see why she was chosen. She even helped raise funds that supported Lottie Moon. Lottie Moon is a story we will address in December. Lol

Thank you for doing mission work right here in our community. You are the missionaries for our time and in our places where we live. May we always be aware of our need to be outward focused.

JIBC app BASICS

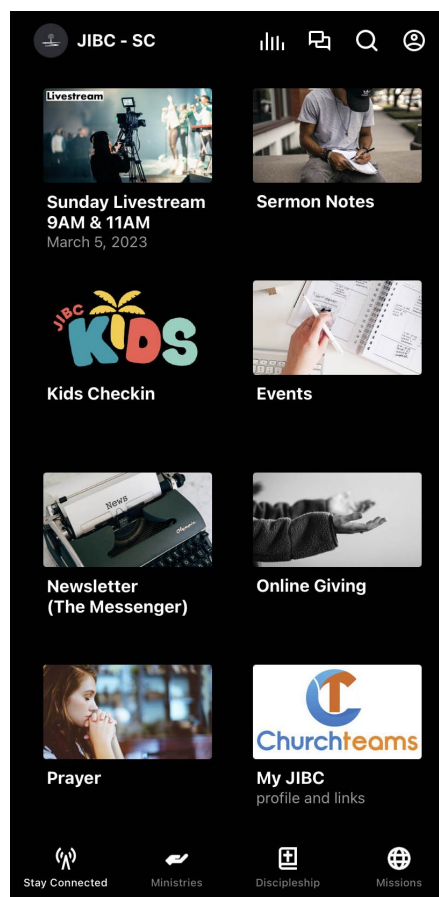
I often get questions about our church online tools, so this article is intended to help you with a few of the basics. The JIBC app can be downloaded to your phone to give you quick and easy access to some great features, many which are not offered on our website. Because we update the app daily, it's also the fastest way to get up-to-date information.

You can get the JIBC app by navigating to the Apple Store or the Google Play Store and entering "James Island Baptist SC" in the search bar. It's free! Once downloaded, the app will appear on your phone as James Island Baptist, SC with our logo. Open it.

There are 4 "hot link" words at the bottom of the screen; *Stay Connected*, *Ministries*, *Discipleship* and *Missions*. Each word opens up a menu of options when you touch it. When you open the app you will automatically be on the *Stay Connected* page. Let's start there.

You will see 8 boxes that help you stay connected to JIBC. The *Sunday Livestream* box will allow you to view the video of the latest worship service. The *Sermon Notes* will give you all the sermon notes for the latest sermon, complete with a fill-in-the-black feature that can reveal the correct answer. This is my favorite part of the app. The *JIBC Kids Checkin* box allows parents to check their kids in fast. The *Events* box shows the upcoming JIBC events with details. The *Newsletter* box will take you to a page where you can open *The Messenger* newsletter, where you can keep up with the latest church menu, the prayer list, Pastor Tom's article, and more. The *Online Giving* box allows you to give online conveniently. The *Prayer* box gives you the ability to write a prayer request. The church office will be notified and Pastor Tom and the staff will lift you up in prayer. The final box is the *My JIBC* (*Churchteams*) box. This allows you to view your profile, the church directory, checkin, give, and more. This will also occasionally allow you to register for upcoming events by typing key words in the message box.

Explore each "hot link" word at the bottom of your screen for more helpful and interesting items. Among the many treasures, you will find a list of Connection Groups, a map of the campus, free Bible study resources, and even a link where you can access the complete Bible in every language.
