


SUMMIT PARK COLLEGE



In Fall 2025, we celebrated the launch of Summit Park College, a brand-new ministry designed to equip the next generation of leaders to follow Jesus and step into their God-given calling. With 11 students in our inaugural class, Summit Park College provides a Christ-centered educational experience in partnership with Evangel University, combining accredited academic learning with hands-on ministry and leadership development. Built on four pillars—college education, personal formation, engaging student life, and real-world experience—students are growing spiritually, developing leadership skills, and gaining practical ministry experience while being fully integrated into the life of Summit Park Church. This new initiative represents a significant step forward in investing in future leaders and creating pathways for long-term Kingdom impact.


