



WORD OF THE WEEK

DAY 1

Genesis : 37: 29-36
What lie did the brothers tell Joseph's dad and where did Joseph end up?

DAY 2

Genesis 39: 20-23
Sounds like Joseph is still being faithful to the Lord and patiently waiting for the dreams to come true. What made Joseph so different even in prison?

DAY 3

Genesis 40: 1-23
After all of those years of being a slave, do you think is was hard for Joseph to be patient, especially after seeing what happened to the cupbearer and chief baker?

Since Joseph was sold by his brothers, how many years had passed in this story? Joseph waited patiently as a slave for all those years!
