Thank you for joining us for worship! Prattville First Methodist Church is a vibrant, caring, and active community of faith, affiliated with the Global Methodist denomination. ### Nursery and Children's Worship

### Sunday School



**Save the date: Rise Against Hunger** meal packing event on March 15, 3:00pm in Pratt Hall. We will be packing 20,000 meals.


### Our featured February mission project: Laundry Love
