Sunday School

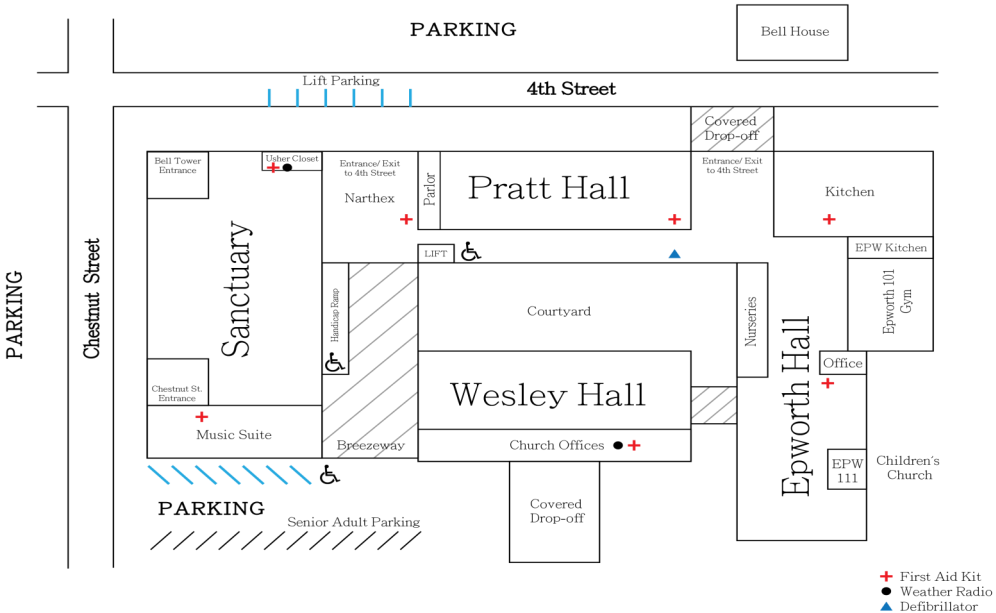

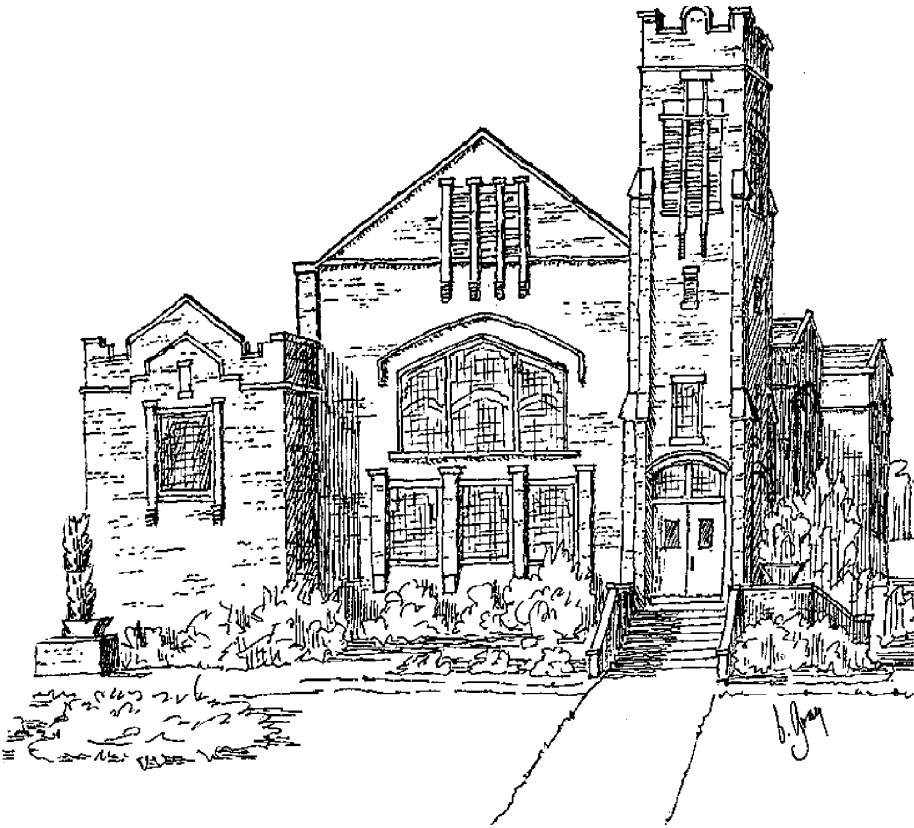
Father Daughter Dance - February 10, 2026 - \$15.00 per person
