From Your Interim Pastor

Let me begin by saying that it is an absolute joy and privilege to be the interim pastor of Olive Branch Baptist Church. I have been extremely impressed by the leadership of this church and how you have continued in the faith in the absence of a full-time pastor. This speaks well of your character and your commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ. It is so exciting to feel the presence of the Holy Spirit each Sunday as we see souls being saved and people transferring their membership to become a part of the body. God is truly in our midst each Sunday. One would wonder with so many things going so well, a great music program, good fellowship, small groups are continuing and the youth group is growing. One would wonder, where do we go from here?

I am reminded of the words from the author of Hebrews chapter 10: 24-25. "And let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near."

The author here is telling all believers that believers are to pay close attention to one another. Faith is not passive or private, it implies awareness, care and purposeful engagement. Why are we to pay such close attention to one another? Because we have been given a duty to spur one another on in love toward Christlike living. In other words, growth in the Christian faith is meant to be relational not isolated. And the natural progression of love, Christlike love, Agape love is good works. Good works is an outward expression of the love that dwells within us who love Jesus and one another. And I will be the first to admit that there are many good works that flow out of Olive Branch Baptist Church. Faith naturally overflows into action.

However, the author of Hebrews gives us a warning. It seems that there were Christians in the early church that were neglecting meeting together on the Lord's Day. Therefore, some believers were not only drifting from meeting with the body of believers, but they were in danger of drifting from the faith. Regular fellowship is essential, not optional for the believer.

However, we see the same problem today as they did in the first century. I believe that decreased church attendance is our biggest problem in America today. Here are a few statistics that reveal this problem.

If you are born between 1925 and 1945 there is a 50% chance that you will be in church on Sunday.

If you were born between 1946 and 1964 there's a 40% chance that you will be in church on Sunday.

If you were born between 1965 and 1983 there's a 20% chance you will be in church on Sunday.

If you were born after 1984 there is less than a 10% chance you will be in church on Sunday. Huston, we have a problem.

Let me encourage you to encourage those that have drifted from the church and perhaps the faith to come back in fellowship with Jesus and the Body. The day of judgment is on the horizon so let us be about the Masters work loving and caring for one another and the lost.


Attention all Seniors!!




