Development Questions

Question #1

This Week's Passage:

Matthew 28:16-20 (NIV)

16 Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. 18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 **Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,** 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Connection Question:

When you hear Jesus' command to "go and make disciples of all nations," what personal response or emotion rises within you?

TRUTH #1:

Jesus Possesses All Authority

Discussion Points:

1. Jesus' authority validates the mission. (John 20:21 NIV)
2. Jesus' authority brings confidence, not fear. (Philippians 4:13 NIV)
3. Jesus' authority assures victory in the mission. (Romans 8:37 NIV)

Growth Question:

What areas of your life would change if you fully trusted His authority?

TRUTH #2:

Jesus Commands Us to Make Disciples

Discussion Points:

1. The command is to "make disciples," not merely converts. (Luke 14:27 NIV)
2. Teaching obedience is essential to discipleship. (John 14:15 NIV)
3. Discipleship requires ongoing investment and relationship. (2 Timothy 2:2 NIV)

Growth Question:

Who has discipled you, and whom might God be calling you to disciple?

TRUTH #3:

Jesus Promises His Continuous Presence

Discussion Points:

1. His presence gives courage for the mission. (Joshua 1:9 NIV)
2. His presence brings peace in uncertainty. (John 14:27 NIV)
3. His presence remains until the mission is complete. (Hebrews 13:5 NIV)

Growth Question:

What practices help you stay aware of His presence?

GO THEREFORE QUESTION:

What next step is Jesus inviting you to take as you participate in His mission to make disciples?

Who are you praying for to be saved?

Question #2

Who can you invite to Church and/or to Small Group?

Question #3

What are your prayer requests?
