Monday – The Call to a Christlike Attitude

Scripture Reading: Philippians 2:1–4

Reflection: Paul calls believers to unity and humility rooted in Christ's encouragement and love. A selfless attitude begins when we intentionally look beyond ourselves and seek the good of others.

Reflection Questions:

1. What attitudes does Paul highlight as essential for Christian living?
2. In what ways do I tend to prioritize my own interests?
3. Where is God inviting me to consider others more intentionally?

Prayer: *Lord, shape my heart to value others above myself and to reflect Your love. Amen.*

Tuesday – Choosing Humility Over Self-Interest

Scripture Reading: Proverbs 16:18–19; Romans 12:3

Reflection: Humility guards our hearts from pride and keeps our perspective aligned with God's truth. Selflessness grows when we recognize our dependence on Him.

Reflection Questions:

1. How does pride show up in my daily life?
2. What does humility look like for me right now?
3. How can I practice humility today?

Prayer: *Father, guard my heart from pride and teach me to walk in humility. Amen.*

Wednesday – Adopting the Mind of Christ

Scripture Reading: Philippians 2:5

Reflection: The Christian life is shaped by intentional thinking. Adopting the mind of Christ means allowing His example to guide our attitudes, choices, and responses.

Reflection Questions:

1. What does having the mind of Christ mean to me?
2. Where do my thoughts differ from Jesus' example?
3. What helps shape my thinking to be Christ-centered?

Prayer: *Jesus, renew my mind and shape my thoughts to reflect Yours. Amen.*

Thursday – Selflessness Through Sacrifice

Scripture Reading: Philippians 2:6–8

Reflection: Jesus willingly humbled Himself and obeyed the Father, even at great personal cost. His sacrifice models true selflessness and obedience.

Reflection Questions:

1. What stands out about Christ's humility?
2. What am I reluctant to surrender to God?
3. How can obedience express selfless love?

Prayer: *Lord, help me surrender my will and follow Your example of obedience. Amen.*

Friday – Serving Others with a Willing Heart

Scripture Reading: Mark 10:42–45; Galatians 5:13-14

Reflection: Service is a natural expression of a selfless attitude. Jesus teaches that greatness in God's kingdom is found in serving others with love.

Reflection Questions:

1. How do I view serving others?
2. Who can I serve intentionally this week?
3. What holds me back from serving with joy?

Prayer: *God, give me a servant's heart and joy in loving others. Amen.*

Saturday – Living for God's Glory

Scripture Reading: Philippians 2:9–11; Colossians 3:12–17

Reflection: Selflessness ultimately points to God's glory. When we live with Christ-like attitudes, God is honored and exalted through our lives.

Reflection Questions:

1. How does Jesus' exaltation encourage selfless living?
2. How can my attitude bring glory to God?
3. What change is God calling me to make?

Prayer: *Father, may my life bring You glory through a selfless attitude. Amen.*
