This is a song that David wrote.

God understands me

Leader: Lord, you look deep inside me, and you know all about me. You know when I sit down, and you know when I get up. Even when you are far away, you understand what I am thinking about.

Congregation: You see me when I go out, and you see me when I stay at home. You know everything that I do! Yes Lord, before I open my mouth to speak, you know what I will say.

Leader: You made every part of me. You made me grow inside my mother before I was born.


ALL: I thank you for the wonderful way that you have made me. Everything that you do is wonderful! I know it is true.






