## FAMILY CONVERSATIONS

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- When do we see Jesus caring for people in the Bible? (Name as many examples as you can!)

- What do we want to say, "thank You" to Jesus for today?
- What is one thing we can do this week to show care for another person or family?



## LIFE CONNECTION

### Random Acts of Care

How can your family care for everyone as Jesus does? Help your kids see that caring for others can be done in little and big ways. It can be a smile, a note, sitting with an older adult or with a new student at lunch, or giving a compliment.

Write "Random Acts of Care" across the top of a posterboard or sheets of paper taped together. As a family, brainstorm random acts of care you can take toward others—people you know and those you don't. Get creative and be excited—your child will follow your lead! Think of ways to show care that cost nothing or very little. The possibilities are endless!

Discuss together: **How do you think others will feel when they are shown a random act of care? What is your favorite act of care on the poster?**

Circle the top five on the list and make plans to do them as a family during the next few weeks. Pray together that God will give you opportunities to care for others the way He does.



## HANDS ON

### Secret Caring Challenge

Yes, Jesus cares for everyone! But on the journey to becoming more like Him, it can be easier to show kindness to people we barely know than it is to the people we know best. As a family, take the Secret Caring Challenge, and practice showing care to those closest to you—family! Commit to doing one secret act of caring to family members every day for three days. Invite each family member to look for a way to show care for someone else in the family. This might include making a sibling's bed, putting away dishes, or writing a note of encouragement and leaving it on the recipient's pillow. The trick is not to tell anyone what you've done!

Around the dinner table each evening, take turns talking about the caring acts you've noticed and guessing who did each one. Talk together about how it felt to do your secret act of caring and how it felt when someone did something caring for you.
