FAMILY CONVERSATIONS

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- What helps you to believe that Jesus has power to heal?
- When and where have you seen the healing power of Jesus?
- Jesus has power to heal, but does this mean He always will?
- Is it hard to believe Jesus can heal? Why or why not?

Flashlight Hide and Seek

Turn off the lights or go into a dark space and let your kids take turns hiding while you use a flashlight to find them. When you shine the light on them, encourage them to call out “Jesus has power!” Take turns hiding and shining the light.

Discuss the following together: **How do you think the man who was blind felt before he was healed? What do you think his life was like? What was it like when you hid in the dark and you couldn’t see?**

Jesus healed the man’s vision so he could see. Jesus is powerful! We can experience His power too. Kind of like the flashlight needs batteries in order to have power, we need Jesus, and we can experience His power and healing too!



WORSHIP RESPONSE

Celebrate How Great Jesus Is!

When the people told Bartimaeus that Jesus calling for him, he jumped to his feet. Then, once he was healed, the man followed Jesus along the road. Jesus deserves to be followed and praised because He sees us, hears us, and has the power to change what is hard in our lives.
