God Gives It To Us; We Give It Away!

Let's read about an event that happened after Jesus was raised from the dead and went to Heaven. The Church started after the Holy Ghost had come upon the 120 believers in the upper room in Acts 2.

This is what He wants us to do today. Let's read this account of Peter and John and let God's courage manifest in us like it did in them.

Acts 3:1-9 KJV Now Peter and John went up together into the Temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour. [2] And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the Temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the Temple; [3] Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the Temple asked an alms. [4] And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us. [5] And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them. [6] Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. [7] And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. [8] And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the Temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. [9] And all the people saw him walking and praising God:

Notice that Peter didn't pray for the man to receive his healing. Peter GAVE the man the healing in Jesus Name. Peter knew that what he had received in the upper room was for him to give away. What did Peter give? He gave healing that came out of the Holy Ghost that was in him. Everyone of us, that are Holy Ghost filled, have power to give people what they need to get free. I've been guilty of praying instead of just giving away what I've got. Don't get me wrong; I'm not saying that we shouldn't pray, but sometimes we don't need to pray; we just need to give what we have, which is the Holy Ghost. Now let's watch Jesus give someone something without praying.

Matthew 9:2-8 KJV And, behold, they brought to Him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee. [3] And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This Man blasphemeth. [4] And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, Wherefore think ye evil in your hearts? [5] For whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk? [6] But that ye may know that the Son of Man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith He to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house. [7] And he arose, and departed to his house. [8] But when the multitudes saw it, they marvelled, and glorified God, which had given such power unto men.

Notice that Jesus said to the man, "Arise take up thy bed". He didn't say, "Let Me pray for you, and maybe My Father will heal you". No, Jesus operated by giving people what He had, by telling them to do something.

I want you to see that we are the people to whom God has given the Holy Ghost in order to give His power to bring His healing to people. We just need to boldly step out and act on His words.
