Living to love!!!!

God's life is the love life; so we could say that He lives to love. He is so excited when His children take His attribute of love and put it into action in their lives. In this Newsletter, I hope you get major revelation that will change you forever. Let's dig into Scriptures that will help us live the love life.

1 Corinthians 13:1-13 NIV If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. [2] If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. [3] If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. [4] Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. [5] It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. [6] Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. [7] It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. [8] Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. [9] For we know in part and we prophesy in part, [10] but when completeness comes, what is in part disappears. [11] When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me. [12] For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. [13] And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

In this chapter we see what the God-kind of love is. The characteristics of His love are very easy to understand, when we study this chapter. I hope you will take the time to read it over and over again. I want you to read it so much that your mind will start thinking about it; even when you're not reading or studying it.

When you became a born-again Christian, you were given the ability, through God's Nature in you, to live this kind of love life. The only thing stopping you is that your mind has to be renewed to think God's way. God's love was shown to us through Jesus' life as recorded in the four gospels; Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Jesus lived out His Father's life while He was on this earth. So spend time renewing your mind with 1 Corinthians 13, then take a few months watching Jesus love like His Father God taught Him to love.

Nobody on this planet loved liked Jesus. Just think about it a little bit; He was living in Heaven with His Father God, then His Father asked Him to come to the earth and start out as a baby. Then He was to grow up and let people hurt Him like no other person has

ever been hurt. By doing this, He would be paying the price for every person's sins that they have ever committed. This is pure love by God the Father, and by His Son! Now that we have received this awesome love gift of salvation, He is asking us to take His example and love others like He has loved us. As I close this Newsletter, I'm giving you more Scriptures to study on this subject. Put them into operation in your life, and you will live like God.

Matthew 5:43-45 KJV Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy. [44] But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; [45] That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for He maketh His sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

1 Peter 3:8-13 KJV Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: [9] Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing. [10] For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: [11] Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. [12] For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and His ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil. [13] And who is he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good?
