Think like God! Live like God!

When the church gets their thinking right, the living right will come automatically. I've watched over the years how people that come to the Christian Center and really put forth effort in changing their thinking, become powerful Christians. In fact, they are so different in their living that all of their family and friends sometimes don't even know them anymore. They are living such a different life.

John 8:31-32 KJV Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on Him, If ye continue in My Word, then are ye My disciples indeed; [32] And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

I want you to think about this; Jesus took some men, that He called His disciples, and turned the world upside down with them. In just three and half years, these men were ready to represent Him to the world. It's been over two thousand years since these men walked the earth, and they still are changing lives by the millions with their writings about Jesus.

My heart's desire is to get people saved so they don't have to go to the devil's hell. My second desire, which burns in me all the time, is to get people to become disciples of Jesus.

What is a disciple? I've given this example for decades now, and I still believe it describes what a true disciple is. A disciple is a follower of someone. Think about this; Matthew, Mark, Luke and John were disciples of Jesus. They watched Him live His Father's life on the earth. They desired to live that same life, and I believe they did so by observation and imitation; they imitated what they saw in Jesus. After Jesus' death and resurrection, He went to Heaven and sent the Holy Spirit to live inside of them. Then the Holy Ghost brought back to their remembrance what Jesus had taught them, and they were able to live out Jesus' life. Let's look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

John 14:26 KJV But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, Whom the Father will send in My Name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 14:25-27 MSG "I'm telling you these things while I'm still living with you. The Friend, the Holy Spirit Whom the Father will send at My request, will make everything plain to you. He will remind you of all the things I have told you. I'm leaving you well and whole. That's my parting gift to you. Peace. I don't leave you the way you're used to being left-feeling abandoned, bereft. So don't be upset. Don't be distraught.

2 Peter 1:13-16 KJV Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance; [14] Knowing that shortly I must put off this my tabernacle, even as our Lord Jesus Christ hath shewed me. [15] Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in remembrance. [16] For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty.

In all these Scriptures we see the word 'remember'. Our thinking has so much to do with our living. If we think like Jesus, we will live like Jesus. If born-again Christians will study the Bible and become its student, they will automatically start living a victorious life on this earth. I'm a living witness of this. I don't have enough words to tell what my life has become since I became a disciple of Jesus; not just a forgiven person. Today I challenge you once again to keep on keeping on with your life of Christ. If you have fallen back into just living the human life, remember back to your former days of discipleship and start living them again.
