Living Life With God's Power and Abilities

When we were born as human beings, we started the process of growing to live our lives based on human learning and understanding. Most of the human race do not even try to receive God's understanding and abilities to live a spiritual life; and because God is a Spirit, they never connect with Him. Now Jesus was completely different than this scenario. We know that, as a baby, He was put into a world that was very sinful; and He was the only One that had never sinned. The reason Jesus never sinned is because He wasn't born from the seed of man. The Holy Ghost hovered over Mary and put a Holy Seed from Heaven inside her womb. So Jesus only had the nature of God in Him. Now He lived two lives at the same time: a natural human life, and also a spiritual life. When we are born again, we live two lives as well. Our new spirit is sinless just like Jesus, but our natural body still has the nature of sin in it. So, as a Christian, the war starts between your spirit and your body. Our body does not want to give control over to our born-again spirit. That's when we must learn about the new spirit person that we are and give our souls (which is our MIND, WILL, AND EMOTIONS) over to our new spirit to control. Now let's look at some Scriptures that bear all this out.

John 3:6-7 KJV That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. [7] Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

John 1:11-13 KJV He came unto His own, and His own received Him not. [12] But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His Name: [13] Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

John 4:6-30 KJV Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with His journey, sat thus on the well: and it was about the sixth hour. [7] There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give Me to drink. [8] (For His disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.) [9] Then saith the woman of Samaria unto Him, How is it that Thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans. [10] Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewst the Gift of God, and Who it is that saith to thee, Give Me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of Him, and He would have given thee living water. [11] The woman saith unto Him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast Thou that living water? [12] Art Thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his

children, and his cattle? [13] Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: [14] But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life. [15] The woman saith unto Him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw. [16] Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither. [17] The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband: [18] For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly. [19] The woman saith unto Him, Sir, I perceive that Thou art a prophet. [20] Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and Ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship. [21] Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe Me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. [22] Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. [23] But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. [24] God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth. [25] The woman saith unto Him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when He is come, He will tell us all things. [26] Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee Am He. [27] And upon this came His disciples, and marvelled that He talked with the woman: yet no man said, What

seekest thou? or, Why talkest Thou with her? [28] The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men, [29] Come, see a Man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ? [30] Then they went out of the city, and came unto Him.

Jesus was telling this lady that there was spiritual water and that she could live a new, spiritual life and never die. Well, she received it! And she is now in Heaven waiting for the new body that God has promised all of us.

The Bible is a book that shows us the spiritual world so that we can live there. When we receive it, we can live in His power and abilities. Always remember the devil and all of his demons are spirits. The way you overcome all of them is to become spiritually minded and know that you are in Jesus, and Jesus is in you.
