### **No Fear Here!!!**

Many people today live wanting to stop fear in their lives. However, they talk about fear ruling them; instead of speaking directly to it and demanding it to leave, in the Name of Jesus. I believe the reason people don't demand fear to leave is because they don't know what fear is. Fear is a spirit; it's not just an emotion. Yes, it will trigger an emotion; but fear is a spirit. Fear is an evil spirit sent from the devil to stop Christians from doing what they know God wants them to do.

Fear is the opposite of faith. When a Christian is operating in the God-kind of faith, there is no fear ruling them. Over the last forty years of my Christian life, I've confronted this evil spirit thousands of times; but now fear knows that I know what he is, and he won't confront me face to face. He will try to come at me from the back. Even if he does get in, he can only stay a short time; because I know how to kick him out. Here is how to kick him out and keep him out: start saying with your mouth what the Word of God says, and he has to leave!!

2 Timothy 1:7 KJV For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind

Hebrews 2:14-15 KJV Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; [15] And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Hebrews 13:5-6 KJV Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. [6] So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

Psalms 23:4 KJV Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me.

Psalms 27:1-6 KJV The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? [2] When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. [3] Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident. [4] One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to enquire in His temple. [5] For in the time of trouble

He shall hide me in His pavilion: in the secret of His tabernacle shall He hide me; He shall set me up upon a rock. [6] And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in His tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the Lord.

Psalm 34:1-4 KJV I will bless the Lord at all times: His praise shall continually be in my mouth. [2] My soul shall make her boast in the Lord : the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad. [3] O magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt His name together. [4] I sought the Lord, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

In all these verses, we see the way to keep fear out of one's life is to speak about your relationship with your God. The spirit of fear cannot win against our God, and our Father God has taken us to be His children.

This week, drive fear out of your life; and do what your God wants you to do.
