What We Are Thinking Is Making Us Or Breaking Us!!!

We know, as Christians, that we are responsible to control our thinking with GOD'S WORDS. We were born again by God giving birth to us with His Word.

1 Peter 1:23 KJV Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

But God didn't give us a new mind; we must renew our minds.

Romans 12:2 KJV And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

The way we renew our minds is by reading and studying the Bible with the intentions of programming our minds to think like God. Also we must start confessing God's Word; we must say the same thing God says. For example, God would never say, "I'm just dying to go". What would He say? He might say something like this, "Let us go in the power of the Holy Ghost". He would never say, "Damn you"; He would probably say, "Bless you".

The Christian Center's Confession Booklet can really help you in changing your thinking and speaking. I received it over 40 years ago, and I have hardly ever missed a day confessing it. I fear to think how my life would have been without it. I know that many people today think that they will be saved if they confess their sins; that is not Scriptural. The Bible tells us to confess 'Jesus as Lord' to be saved, not to confess our sins. Now after we are born again and we sin, we are to confess it and acknowledge that we have done wrong; but confessing your sins can never save you from hell. In this next verse we see what saves us.

Romans 10:9-10 KJV That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. [10] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

The more you say or sing something, the more it will get into your heart; this is how we renew our minds. When you think like God, the devil will really have no power over you.

Hebrews 3:1 KJV Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;

The word profession has the same meaning as confession. What does confession mean? First, it is affirming something we believe. Second, it is testifying to something we know. Third, it is witnessing to a truth that we have embraced. Every one us can do these things, and our lives will be filled with God's presence.
