Living the Faith Life!

The Faith that we receive from God's Word will activate our Father God in our life.

Romans 1:16-17 KJV For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. [17] For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Notice that it says the just shall live by faith. How do you do that? Well let's look at Romans 10:17 KJV

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

Christians that live by faith are simply finding out what God's Word says to them and acting it out in real life.

Here's an example...

James 5:16-20 KJV Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. [17] Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. [18] And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit. [19] Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him; [20] Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

In these verses we see God telling us to not deny our faults, but to confess them one to another. Then He starts talking about praying for each other. Through these prayers, we see healing can take place in people that have become physically sick. Then he started talking about Elijah praying and stopping the rain for three years, then praying again and starting the rain.

So when we act on what God tells us in faith, we can expect to see God's power bring to pass what we are praying. To me it's really simple: find out what God says in the Bible, start acting it out, and then you will start seeing God's power and results. Let's look at some more actions we should do based on the Word of God.

Hebrews 10:23 KJV Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

Now the word profession here is the same as the word confession. The word confession means to say the same thing. So if I am to hold fast the profession, or confession, of faith, I will never stop saying what God's Word says in faith. In the Christian Center's Confession Booklet, we have personalized some Scriptures from God's Word for all of us to confess daily. I've been speaking these confessions now for over forty years, and I have watched God perform these confessions in my life. I am truly a real witness to God's power transforming one's life!

Let's look at some more Scriptures on this subject.

Mark 11:22-23 KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

We see God giving us an example of what a person can do, if they have faith in what they say. Jesus told us that, if we were to hear God tell us to move a mountain, we could actually speak to that mountain; and it would have to move. So many things in the Bible need to be spoken out in faith so that our Father God can have His will done in our lives and in the lives of others.

I challenge you, once again, to not stop speaking the Confession Booklet every day. If you do this in faith, believe that what you say in faith will have

to come to pass. I hope you will come to The Christian Center this Sunday. The Bible says to not forsake the assembly of ourselves together. Don't let the devil trick you and make you think you can just stay home and watch online; we need each other's presence.
