How to Receive God's Blessings in Your Life

God is no respecter of persons. God loves everyone equally. God will never help one person but turn down others. Let's look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

Acts 10:34-35 KJV Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: [35] But in every nation he that feareth Him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with Him.

After Jesus' resurrection and ascension, Peter preached to the first non-Jewish people to receive Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Before this day, Jewish people believed that the Gentiles couldn't be saved. Well, things changed after that day; because revelation had come that God was no respecter of persons. I don't know if you've ever been lied to by the devil in this area or not. We hear that God did something awesome for someone, and we immediately think 'He wouldn't do that for me'. You might have received Jesus and been born again, and you still think that God treats people differently. This is one of the devil's major lies to keep people from receiving from the Lord.

The Bible is made up of two Testaments; the Old and the New. We, as born again Christians, are under the New Testament; and this is not just God writing a book of history. It is a legal Document written for God's heirs to receive their inheritance. When you receive Jesus, you're not just a forgiven sinner; you are an heir of God Almighty! If you go to the New Testament and find out what Jesus desires for you to receive, you can have it by claiming it by faith. In these next verses, we can see God writing about His heirs.

Romans 8:16-17 KJV The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: [17] And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

Galatians 3:29 KJV And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Galatians 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Hebrews 1:14 KJV Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Hebrews 6:17-18 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of

promise the immutability of His counsel, confirmed it by an oath: [18] That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

James 2:5 KJV Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which He hath promised to them that love Him?

The reason some people don't receive as much from God as others is because some claim more of their inheritance. You claim it by studying the New Testament and finding out what Jesus' desire is for you; then declare that it is yours as a rightful heir; and receive it into your life by faith.

God wants you to be filled with His power and blessings, but you must do first things first. Study and find out what is yours.
