I Am Born Twice

John 3:6-8 KJV That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. [7] Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. [8] The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Every born-again Christian can live a new life, because they are born again spiritually to do so. The sad thing is that most of the Christians never live that life while they are in their natural body, because they don't identify as spirit. My Father God has given me a mandate to teach His church to start self identifying as what they are spiritually as the Bible teaches. This Newsletter is just another teaching on this subject. I will probably be on this till Jesus comes back, or till I go to Heaven. I want to encourage you to take the Scriptures that I reference in this Newsletter and study them till they become a reality in your thinking. So let us start by referencing Scriptures that you probably already know.

John 3:6 KJV That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

Jesus said there are two birthdays for a believer. A birthday for the body and a birthday for the spirit. The body birth starts a physical life that will die. The spirit birth starts an eternal life that will never die. When we receive this new spiritual birth, we are changed on the inside. Our spirit that is in our body is born from the seed of God's Word.

1 Peter 1:23 KJV Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

Many Christians today are trying to live a Godly life without identifying that they are Godly. The reason for this is because they don't identify as spirits;

they identify as their bodies. The human body is just a house for the spirit to live in. Once Christians start identifying as the new spirit that they are, they will have the ability to live like what they are. All Christians are born from God, the inner spirit man has the same DNA as God. We can and will live Godly as we identify as the new spirit person that we are in Christ.

Romans 8:15-18 KJV For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. [16] The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: [17] And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together. [18] For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Romans 8:30-39 KJV Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified. [31] What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? [32] He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? [33] Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. [34] Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, Who also maketh intercession for us. [35] Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? [36] As it is written, For Thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. [37] Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us. [38] For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, [39] Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

In all these verses, God is telling us to identify with our new spirit person; not just our natural life. We are eternal beings, because we are spirits just

like God our Father. He is a Spirit; we are spirits. We must think spirit to be victorious in this life.
