



**Pastor Paul's Newsletter 2-15-26**  
**Jesus is Lord of ALL!**

Every born-again Christian entered into the Kingdom of God when they were born again. They now have the King's protection and provisions, because they've been translated out of the kingdom of darkness and into the Kingdom of God's dear Son. When the enemy comes in to try to mess with the born-again Christian, he's not just fighting against a person, he is fighting against the King of kings and the Lord of lords! The only ability the devil has to win against a Christian is through that Christian's lack of understanding of who they are in God's Kingdom. Satan is helpless to overpower a born-again Christian who knows who they are!

So in this Newsletter, we will be sharing with you the complete failure of the devil's kingdom after Jesus came to this earth and defeated him and made a show of him openly triumphing over him in it. We Christians must rise up in Jesus' authority and enforce the victory that Jesus has already won! Now let's look at some Scripture verses that show us just how powerful we are in Christ.

Colossians 1:12-27 KJV Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: [13] Who hath delivered us from the

power of darkness, and hath translated us into the Kingdom of His dear Son: [14] In Whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins: [15] Who is the image of the invisible God, the Firstborn of every creature: [16] For by Him were all things created, that are in Heaven, and that are in Earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him: [17] And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist. [18] And He is the head of the Body, the Church: Who is the beginning, the Firstborn from the dead; that in all things He might have the preeminence. [19] For it pleased the Father that in Him should all fulness dwell; [20] And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, I say, whether they be things in Earth, or things in Heaven. [21] And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath He reconciled [22] In the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in His sight: [23] If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under Heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister; [24] Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for His body's sake, which is the church: [25] Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is

given to me for you, to fulfil the Word of God; [26] Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to His saints: [27] To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

Romans 8:31-39 KJV What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? [32] He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? [33] Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. [34] Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, Who is even at the right hand of God, Who also maketh intercession for us. [35] Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? [36] As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. [37] Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us. [38] For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, [39] Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

We Christians have come into Jesus, and everything that

Jesus has is ours. Jesus has all power over all the power of the enemy, and He's given us His Name: the Name which is above every name; and at His Name, every knee shall bow and every tongue shall confess that He is Lord of All!!

Acts 10:34-38 KJV Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: [35] But in every nation he that feareth Him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with Him. [36] The word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (He is Lord of all:) [37] That word, I say, ye know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached; [38] How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: Who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him.

The Church of Jesus is one spirit with Jesus, so the devil is completely defeated against Jesus; and he is defeated against us as well - if we know it.
