Led or Guided by the Holy Spirit

If you were going to die physically unless you made it through a dangerous jungle, what would you desire more than anything to be able make it through and survive? You guessed it! A knowledgeable guide of the jungle would be correct, and your survival rate would be increased substantially. As your Pastor, I've got some good news for you today. God has provided for you a Guide to help you navigate through this dangerous world we live in. The devil has so many dangerous traps in this world for the human race to be caught in; but if a person receives the Holy Spirit to be their Guide, they can bypass the danger. In this Newsletter I will share with you how to connect with the Holy Spirit through your reborn spirit, so that you can receive His guidance. Let's look at some Scriptures to start with, and go on from there.

Romans 8:14-16 KJV For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. [15] For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. [16] The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

In these verses we see that when we are born-again Christians, we receive the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit has a mission, and His mission is to lead every child of God. The word 'lead' can be used interchangeably with 'guide'. So let's look at verse 14 again. The Holy Spirit will guide us. Well if the Holy Spirit is going to guide us, how does He do it? In verse 16 He says that the Holy Spirit bears witness with our spirit. This means the Holy Spirit is actually talking to our reborn spirit. Notice He didn't say he is talking to us through our mind, will or emotions; He is talking to our spirit man. You are a spirit, you have a soul (mind, will, and emotions), and you live in a body. God does not lead us through our emotions or minds or through the five senses in our bodies. He leads us through our reborn spirits. So this means that born again Christians must allow themselves to become spiritually conscious; meaning that our spirits must connect with our minds. We must become spiritually minded.

Let me give you example: the phones that we have today can be connected to other devices. For instance; I have an iPhone and I bought some earbuds. If I connect to the ear buds, I can listen privately to my phone in my ears. The next question is how do I connect the earbuds to my iPhone? I have to turn on the bluetooth on my phone, the my phone will immediately start searching for devices. Now my phone won't connect with my earbuds if I don't turn the earbuds on to search. When both the earbuds and the phone are in the search mode, they are looking to hook up; and when they find each,

other the connection is made, and they can flow together. What's in the phone can be transported to the earbuds. The same thing happens when your born again spirit hooks up with your mind. The Holy Spirit is speaking to your spirit, and you can hear it in your mind; because your mind has been connected. The apostle Paul said this:

Romans 8:5-6 KJV For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. [6] For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

When a believer starts seeking God, they must recognize that God's Holy Spirit is in their spirit. They must connect their mind to their spirit before they will be able to find Him and receive what they need. When a person is carnally minded, this means that their mind is connected to the natural world through their five senses instead of the Holy Spirit and their own spirits. This Newsletter will help you connect your mind and your spirit. Because your spirit is the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit, you will find Him there. Speaking in spiritual tongues will connect you to your spirit as well.

1 Corinthians 14:14-15 KJV For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. [15] What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.

My desire, as your Pastor, is for you to be guided into all the things that God wants you to experience. Don't allow the devil to beat you out of this wonderful life. I'm talking about the Holy Spirit led life. He will show you what you should do, and what you shouldn't. Life will be so much easier as you are guided by the precious Holy Spirit. Let's look at this last Scripture before I close this Newsletter.

John 16:13-14 KJV Howbeit when He, the Spirit of Truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will shew you things to come. [14] He shall glorify Me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall shew it unto you.
