Living the Love Life!

John 3:16-17 KJV For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. [17] For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.

In this world there are a lot of people that are not giving or receiving much love; and because of this, they are not functioning like God designed them to function. Everyone needs love, from the youngest to the oldest. We were made by God in His own likeness, and He is love; and He made mankind to love and to receive love. We will be looking in the Scriptures today to reveal this wonderful revelation, so let us begin.

John 15:9-17 KJV As the Father hath loved Me, so have I loved you: continue ye in My love. [10] If ye keep My commandments, ye shall abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His love. [11] These things have I spoken unto you, that My joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. [12] This is My commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. [13] Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. [14] Ye are My friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. [15] Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of My Father I have made known unto you. [16] Ye have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in My Name, He may give it you. [17] These things I command you, that ye love one another.

In these words of Jesus we see over and over again Love. Jesus knows that if you are not receiving His love, and also giving love, you are really not functioning like Heaven. Jesus said pray that His Kingdom come in the earth just like Heaven. There is no hate in Heaven; there is no unforgiveness in Heaven. Everyone and everything in Heaven is operating in God's love.

1 John 3:1-2 KJV Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew Him not. [2] Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is.

4:7-12,16-18 KJV Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. [8] He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. [9] In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. [10] Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. [11] Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. [12] No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and His love is perfected in us. [16] And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. [17] Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world. [18] There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

In all these verses we see how our Father God wanted to have a family that He could love. God cannot be fulfilled if we don't receive His love and give His love, because He is Love and because we are born again from His seed, we are His little love Kids.
