We Can Think Like God!

John 15:7-8 KJV If ye abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. [8] Herein is My Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be My disciples.

Proverbs 4:20-23 NLT My child, pay attention to what I say. Listen carefully to my words. [21] Don't lose sight of them. Let them penetrate deep into your heart, [22] for they bring life to those who find them, and healing to their whole body. [23] Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life.

Psalm 1:1-3 AMPC Blessed (happy, fortunate, prosperous, and enviable) is the man who walks and lives not in the counsel of the ungodly [following their advice, their plans and purposes], nor stands [submissive and inactive] in the path where sinners walk, nor sits down [to relax and rest] where the scornful [and the mockers] gather. [2] But his delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God) he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night. [3] And he shall be like a tree firmly planted [and tended] by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade or wither; and everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity].

So many Christians think that God is a respecter of persons. They watch people in the church receiving from God, but it seems like they never do. They just don't understand

that our Father God is not obligated to give us what we want, if it's not in the Bible. We must learn the Bible, so we can know what God wants in our lives. Then we bring God's Word to Him in prayer and make a petition for it to be brought into our lives.
