

## The Supernatural Church

Are you desiring to live a life surrendered to God? Do you desire to have the power of God flow through you? If your answer is yes to these questions, this Newsletter is for you.

I've always been a visionary; even when I was a little boy, I would use my imagination at sports or hunting. I got married at the age of 18, and although I wasn't a man yet, I was a big dreamer. LeJeune took a chance in marrying me; but after over 50 years of marriage, it's paid off.

When I started listening to Brother Kenneth Copeland on TV in 1980, something really changed in my life. He started preaching about God doing supernatural things through the Church. He said that God has never changed His ways of doing things and that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. That changed my mind and life forever! (**Hebrews 13:8 KJV**) Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

When He preached on this verse, I knew beyond a shadow of a doubt that God never intended for the Church to stop doing supernatural works. The Church has settled for READING the history of the Bible instead of MAKING history.

Now I want you to think about somethings that will cause you to desire the supernatural ways of God. The book of Acts has the accounts of God doing supernatural things through natural man. Jesus left earth and went to Heaven, but He sent the Holy Ghost in Acts the second chapter; and the Church was birthed. The followers of Jesus were full of power and the Holy Ghost, and they immediately started doing miracles. It was like Jesus was still on the earth. There was powerful preaching and teaching in those days, just like we have today, but something was different then; the Word preached had signs and wonders happening with it.

In 30 years of ministry I've had some miraculous things happen through the power of the Holy Ghost, but I don't think we have seen anything yet. If Jesus is coming quickly, and I believe He is, we need to get prepared for great supernatural acts. The Church must believe that God wants to fill them with His Spirit and flow out of them. When the Holy Ghost does healing and miracles through us, the world will start listening to our preaching and teaching.

I would like for you to study **2 Kings**, chapters 1-4 with this in mind: Jesus is a type of Elijah and the Church is a type of Elisha. As you read the accounts of these two men, remember that they represent our supernatural God and the supernatural Church. If you want to be part of this supernatural way of living, imagine yourself as Elisha.

Here are a couple of verses from what you will be studying to whet your appetite.

**2 Kings 2:9-10 KJV** And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me. [10] And he said, Thou hast asked a hard thing: nevertheless, if thou see me when I am taken from thee, it shall be so unto thee; but if not, it shall not be so.

Jesus has been taken up, and we are on the earth with His power to do the same works and greater. Get ready for your life to radically change. The world needs the supernatural Church to help them. We see many people getting sick, and they need us. Get ready for God's empowerment for you to heal, it's called the anointing.
