Living Heaven While on the Earth!

All Christians have bodies that bind us to Earth, but we have born-again spirits that loose us to live in the spirit; and there is no time or distance in the spirit. We can connect with Heaven through our spirits while we still live in our bodies on Earth.

Hebrews 12:22-26 KJV But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, [23] To the general assembly and church of the Firstborn, which are written in Heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, [24] And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel. [25] See that ye refuse not Him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from Him that speaketh from Heaven: [26] Whose voice then shook the earth: but now He hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also Heaven.

This physical world, made of matter, is real to us because of our five senses which tell us that it is real. The world of the spirit is more real than the natural world. God is a Spirit, and we must learn how to function in both worlds at the same time. The Holy Ghost, along with God's Holy Bible, will bring the spiritual world into reality for us; just like our five senses bring the natural world into reality. Let us look at Scriptures that bear this out.

Hebrews 3:1, KJV Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; Hebrews 4:14-16 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. [15] For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we

are, yet without sin. [16] Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Notice in these verses that Jesus is passed into the heavens, and He is the High Priest of our profession. The word 'profession' in the Greek is confession. When Jesus the High Priest hears us confessing His Word on the earth, He makes decrees for those things to come to pass. The angels then start working to bring them from the spiritual world into the natural five-sense world.

Hebrews 1:13-14 KJV But to which of the angels said He at any time, Sit on My right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? [14] Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

When we speak God's words on the earth in faith, our High Priest Jesus is listening; and He commands the angels to go to work to bring them to pass. Heaven is working through us, as believers, to birth things of God's spiritual Kingdom into this natural world. Here are some Scriptures that bear this out.

Matthew 18:18-20 AMP I assure you and most solemnly say to you, whatever you bind [forbid, declare to be improper and unlawful] on Earth shall have [already] been bound in Heaven, and whatever you loose [permit, declare lawful] on Earth shall have [already] been loosed in Heaven. [19] "Again I say to you, that if two believers on Earth agree [that is, are of one mind, in harmony] about anything that they ask [within the will of God], it will be done for them by My Father in Heaven. [20] For where two or three are gathered in My Name [meeting together as My followers], I am there among them."

Ephesians 1:3-5, KJV Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: [4] According as He hath chosen us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love:

[5] Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, Ephesians 2:5-7 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) [6] And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: [7] That in the ages to come He might shew the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

God is right now revealing His spiritual Kingdom to His church, which we are. We are seeing through the Bible and the Holy Ghost the world of God's spiritual Kingdom. Always remember that the natural five-sense world was created by the Holy Ghost and God's Word. We can now bring God's creative Power into this natural world to fix whatever is wrong.
