Living a Spirit Filled Life!

Acts 1:4-8 KJV And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith He, ye have heard of Me. [5] For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence. [6] When they therefore were come together, they asked of Him, saying, Lord, wilt Thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel? [7] And He said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in His own power. [8] But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Well it happened, and praise God it is happening today! Anyone that wants to be filled with God's Spirit can be and live a life being led by the precious Holy Spirit. I have been filled with the Holy Spirit, and I know that The Christian Center is a direct result of that. My Father God has touched thousands of people's lives over these last 40 years since I received the Holy Spirit.

I will finish this Newsletter with Scriptures that reveal the Holy Spirit's ministry through the church then and today.

John 14:15-20 KJV If ye love Me, keep My commandments. [16] And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever; [17] Even the Spirit of truth; Whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth Him not, neither knoweth Him: but ye know Him; for He dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. [18] I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. [19] Yet a little while, and the world seeth Me no more; but ye see Me: because I live, ye shall live also. [20] At that day ye shall know that I am in My Father, and ye in Me, and I in you.

15:26 KJV But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, He shall testify of Me:

16:7, 13-15 KJV Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you...[13] Howbeit when He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will shew you things to come. [14] He shall glorify Me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall shew it unto you. [15] All things that the Father hath are Mine: therefore said I, that He shall take of Mine, and shall shew it unto you.

John 16:14-15 TPT He will glorify Me on the earth, for He will receive from Me what is Mine and reveal it to you. [15] Everything that belongs to the Father belongs to Me—that's why I say that the Divine Encourager will receive what is Mine and reveal it to you.

The Holy Spirit is in us, so now we must connect with Him through faith.

Hebrews 11:1 AMPC Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

I can't physically see the Holy Spirit living in me, but I know He is there by my faith. We are Holy Spirit containers.

1 Corinthians 6:19 AMPC Do you not know that your body is the temple (the very sanctuary) of the Holy Spirit Who lives within you, Whom you have received [as a Gift] from God? You are not your own,
